# Jurors Hear 3 Witnesses On Slaying

## Doctors, Detective Testify in Case Involving Carter

**PATERSON** — The Passaic County Grand Jury heard its first witnesses yesterday in its investigation of the slaying of three persons at the Lafayette Grill in Paterson last June.

Those called before the jurors were Dr. William Van Vooren, assistant county medical examiner; Dr. Allan Ellis, pathologist at Paterson General Hospital, and County Detective Lieutenant Vincent De Simone.

De Simone was before the jury two hours.

Charged with the slayings are Rubin (Hurricane) Carter, middleweight championship contender, and his sparring partner, John Artis.

On June 17, two men entered the tavern and opened fire with a pistol and a shotgun, fatally wounding George Oliver, 52, the bartender; George Nuyoks, 60, of Cedar Grove, and Mrs. Hazel Tanis, 51, of 176 Lafayette Ave., Hawthorne, patrons. Mrs. Tanis died two weeks later.
