**Murder Jury -  
Still Incomplete**

**PATERSON** — Selection of three more jurors in the Rubin (Hurricane) Carter-John Artis murder trial continues today before Superior Court Judge Samuel A. Larner, after a day in which 13 persons were interviewed, but none were chosen.

Carter, 30, of 498 20th Ave., ranking middleweight boxing crown contender, and Artis, 22, of 5 Tyler St., a former high school track star, both of Paterson, are accused of killing three persons in a tavern shooting last June 17, in Paterson.

Killed instantly in the early morning shooting were James Oliver, 52, bartender and part owner of the Lafayette Grill, 428 E. 18th St., Paterson, where the shooting occurred and a patron, Fred Nauyoks, 60, of 89 Pompton Ave., Cedar Grove.

Another patron, Mrs. Hazel Tanis, 51, of 176 Lafayette AVE., Hawthorne, died several weeks later, William Marins, 42, of 225 Keen St., Paterson, a third patron, was critically wounded but has recovered.

The state, represented by Assistant Prosecutor Vincent E. Hull Jr., is seeking the death penalty.
